Health and Safety Information

- **Health and safety precautions while in the building and on the grounds:**
 - Maintain a minimum 6-foot distance from others.
 - Wear a face covering.
 - Do not hug, shake hands or engage in any other physical contact.
 - Maintain good hygiene by sneezing or coughing into a tissue or your elbow, sanitizing your hands frequently by washing or using hand sanitizer, and not touching your face.
 - Leave the building or grounds immediately if you begin to feel unwell. However, please notify one of the ushers about your condition so that the elders can contact you later.

- **Do not enter the building if:**
 - You are symptomatic of COVID-19,
 - You have a fever or persistent cough,
 - You feel generally unwell,
 - You have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or
 - You have traveled internationally or to a domestic hot spot in the past two weeks.

- **Steps for entering / exiting the building:**
 - Go to the steps in front of the auditorium where your temperature will be checked.
 - After your temperature is checked, move to the middle of the drive-through and wait for a greeter to indicate that you may enter the building. The doors will be opened for you.
 - Please proceed to one of the open auditorium doors and do not congregate in the foyer.
 - Upon entering the auditorium, wait for an usher to direct you to your seat(s).
Whenever possible, families / households will be seated together on the same pew.
Children should remain with their parents or guardians at all times.
 - Following services, please wait for your row to be dismissed. When dismissed, exit the front doors of the building and do not congregate in the foyer.

- **Other considerations:**
 - Upon entering the auditorium, an usher will hand you a pre-filled communion cup. If you have trouble opening a pre-filled communion cup, ask the usher about alternatives.
 - After we observe the Lord's Supper, place your empty communion cup in the cupholder on the back of the pew in front of you.
 - After worship services, please drop your empty communion cup in one of the trash cans at the rear of the auditorium.
 - Contributions can be placed in one of the designated boxes in the rear of the auditorium.
